# BEFORE WE BEGIN

Types of Fasting and what they require

## Broad Types

1. **Corporate:** This is a called fast done by the Pastor or Leader of a church or group of people. (see 1 Kings 21:9, Ezra 8:21, Ester 4:16) This type of fast requires that the people are on one accord about the fast and agree with what the Senior Pastor or Leader, by the leading of Holy Spirit, has called them to do.

2. **Private:** This is a personal fast by an individual or husband and wife, led by the Lord (see Matthew 6:18).

## Specific Types of Fasts

1. ***Daniel Fast:*** No meat, no bread, sweet foods, or strong drinks (see Daniel 10:2-3). This fast can be done for an extended period. This fast could also be considered a vegetarian diet because there is no meat intake. This is the type of Fasting that LCM is encouraging the body to prayerfully consider doing this year.

2. ***Partial Fast:*** This would include not eating one main meal that you would usually eat on a daily routine, such as breakfast, or lunch, or dinner. This meal would be skipped until the fast was over.

3. **Half-Day:** Fast until 3 P.M. (ninth hour). This is the fast John Wesley participated in. (see Acts 10:30-31)

4. **Complete Fast:** This would require you to abstain from all solid foods, having liquids only. When Jesus fasted in the desert, the Bible says, "After fasting forty days and forty nights, He was hungry." This verse does not mention Jesus being thirsty. (see Luke 4:1-2)

5. **Total Fast:** This is a full and complete fast, no food or drink. Acts 9:9 describes when Paul went on a full fast for three days following his encounter with Jesus on the road to Damascus. Esther also called for this type of fast in Esther 4:15-16. This type of fast should be done with extreme caution and not for extended periods of time.

6. **Juice Fast:** This is a fast where only fresh fruits and vegetables are juiced in a juicer. If you can't juice your own fruits or veggies, try buying juices without sugar or additives. When using fruits that are acidic, such as lemons, oranges, and even tomatoes, dilute them with water for your stomach's sake.

## LENGTHS OF FASTS

1. Half-Day: see Judges 20:26, Acts 10:30

2. One Day/24hrs



3.Three Days: see Acts 9:9, Esther 4:15-16

4.Seven Days: see 1 Samuel 31:13

5.Fourteen Days: see Acts 27:33

6.Twenty-One Days: see Daniel 10:3

7.Forty Days: see 1 Kings 19:8, Luke 4:1-2

NOTE: The length of the fast should be dependent on three factors – 1. Your health, 2) God’s leading, and 3) Type of fast. USING WISDOM IS ALWAYS IMPORTANT IN FASTING.

\*You are welcomed to fast as long as you want to, but the corporate schedule is established to consecrate each month.

## **DIRECTIONS FOR USING DEVOTIONAL:**

Each day we encourage you to read the scriptures out loud and then read the corresponding devotional. Once you have completed the devotional, take the time to meditate on what you read or on a thought the Holy Spirit has quickened in your spirit. After that, you can either pray using the prayer provided, or you can pray as you feel prompted by the Holy Spirit or by your specific needs. Lastly, we have provided a short decree using one of the covenantal names of the Lord. Remember that decrees must be spoken out loud.

# DAY 1

## MOVING FORWARD

*After the death of Moses, the servant of the Lord, the Lord said to Joshua, son of Nun, Moses' aide: "Moses my servant is dead. Now then, you and all these people, get ready to cross the Jordan River into the land I am about to give to them—to the Israelites. 3 I will give you every place where you set your foot, as I promised Moses. Your territory will extend from the desert to Lebanon, and from the great river, the Euphrates—all the Hittite country—to the Mediterranean Sea in the west. No one will be able to stand against you all the days of your life. As I was with Moses, so I will be with you; I will never leave you nor forsake you. - Joshua 1:1-5*

*This is the message which we have heard from Him and declare to you, that God is light and in Him is no darkness at all. If we say that we have fellowship with Him, and walk in darkness, we lie and do not practice the truth. But if we walk in the light as He is in the light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus Christ His Son cleanses us from all sin. If we say that we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us. If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness. 1 John 1:5-9*

*...but as He who called you is holy, you also be holy in all your conduct, because it is written, "Be holy, for I am holy." 1 Peter 1:15-16*

## DEVOTIONAL

Israel has just spent 40 years in the wilderness after leaving Egypt. As they traveled, there were moments where they failed, moments where they struggled, and times when they learned more about the character of God. During their travel, they had Moses leading them, praying for them, and protecting them, but now we read that Moses is dead. Moses represents more than a leader but a way of living and operating. But now God has chosen Joshua to carry Israel into the promised land. We learn a great deal from this simple phrase, "Moses my servant is dead." (Joshua 1:2a) It was a signal that God was moving them forward into a new way of living, thinking, and acquiring the long-awaited promise.

Today, we are preparing to move forward from the failures, the struggles, the pains, and the sins of our past and embrace the grace and promise of God. Before we take another step, let us evaluate areas in our lives that we need to repent about, seek the forgiveness of others, or cycles of behavior that we need to end. While this may not be easy for everyone, list the areas that you need to target during this time of fasting and prayer so that you can experience the fulness of God's promise for your life and for your community of faith.

# PRAYER

“Father, I thank you for this time to move forward from areas of struggle, adversity, and the sin that held me hostage. Today I repent of any sin or failure that has caused me to be insensitive to your voice and your will for my life. Forgive me for my sins and give me the grace to overcome areas of struggle in my life so that I may pursue your will for my life. I thank you for sending your son to die for me, and I fully embrace his death, burial, and resurrection in Jesus’ name. Amen.”

# DECREE

I decree that You are *Jehovah Makedesh (Exodus 31:13, Leviticus 20:7,8)*, You are the God that sanctifies us. I declare that according to Romans 12:1-2, my mind and my heart are being transformed by your word and presence. I purify my thoughts, my actions, and my will until your glory is revealed in me.

# REFLECTIONS

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# DAY 2

## BE COURAGEOUS

*Be strong and courageous because you will lead these people to inherit the land I swore to their ancestors to give them. "Be strong and very courageous. Be careful to obey all the law my servant Moses gave you; do not turn from it to the right or to the left, that you may be successful wherever you go. Keep this Book of the Law always on your lips; meditate on it day and night so that you may be careful to do everything written in it. Then you will be prosperous and successful. Have I not commanded you? Be strong and courageous. Do not be afraid; do not be discouraged, for the Lord your God will be with you wherever you go." Joshua 1: 6-9*

*I can do all things through Christ who strengthens me. Philippians 4:13*

*But without faith it is impossible to please Him, for he who comes to God must believe that He is, and that He is a rewarder of those who diligently seek Him. Hebrews 11:6*

## DEVOTIONAL

After the death of Moses, Israel now has to embrace a new leader. Their new leader needs to fulfill the promise of entering a new life on the other side of the Jordan River. But

to take on this responsibility, Joshua will need to focus on three areas in his life: being strong, being courageous, and trusting God.

The Lord tells Joshua that you need to “Be strong.” Strength is an internal attribute that simply implies that as a believer, you need to be firm and confident in spite of the obstacles that are before you. Here is where you dig deep and say to yourself, “I can do all things through Christ who strengthens me.” (Philippians 4:13) No matter what the obstacle may be in your life – you can achieve it by defying your fears and apprehensions.

Secondly, the Lord says, “Be courageous” or simply be bold. Whenever God calls you into something new, you need the boldness and determination to know that God is for you. Whenever God opens an opportunity to get a house, or a new job, or even acquire a piece of property, you need to have the courage to step out with the boldness which comes from a deepened relationship with the Father.

Lastly, you need to trust God and His word. Words like obedience, focus, and faith are words that imply confidence in what God had promised Moses and now will carry out in the life of Joshua. But it requires Joshua to trust God as Moses did. If you want to see the promises of God manifest in your life – you must believe God, trust His Word, and know that He is a rewarder of those that diligently seek Him (Hebrews 11:6). When you trust God’s word, you can be strong and courageous, and you will experience the grace that He gives so freely.



# PRAYER

Father, as I enter into this new season in my life, I ask you to release your love and favor into my life. I ask you to strengthen my faith and give me the courage to face every challenge in my life. Father, give me the desire to pursue your will and your presence in my life. Father, help me to overcome my fears and anxieties so that I may enter into the promises that you sat before me. Thank you for giving me the grace to overcome every challenge that life brings before me. In Jesus' name.

# DECREE

I decree that you are Jehovah-Rohi (Psalm 23). You are the Lord who is my shepherd. I decree that you will lead and guide me in the path that I will go. I prophetically declare that my confidence is in You and in Your word. I have been created to be a victor and not a victim, a conqueror and not conquered, and a covenant child of Jehovah-Rohi.

# REFLECTIONS

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# DAY 3

## BE FULL OF FAITH

*So Jesus answered and said to them, "Have faith in God. For assuredly, I say to you, whoever says to this mountain, 'Be removed and be cast into the sea,' and does not doubt in his heart, but believes that those things he says will be done, he will have whatever he says. Therefore, I say to you, whatever things you ask when you pray, believe that you receive them, and you will have them. Mark 11:22-24*

*Jesus said unto him, If thou canst believe, all things are possible to him that believeth. Mark 9:23*

*Faith is the confidence that what we hope for will actually happen; it gives us assurance about things we cannot see. Hebrews 11:1*

## DEVOTIONAL

Jesus and his disciples had just passed by a fig tree that was dried from the root, Peter remembered how Jesus cursed the fig tree, and now that same tree lays lifeless. Jesus then takes a moment to teach his disciples about the importance of faith. But what is faith? ***Faith is the supernatural power of God made available to you so that you can transform conditions, circumstances, and situations based on the will of God.*** Let us be very clear; faith is not positive

thinking. Faith can only be released where the will of God is known (Romans 10:17).

The first principle of faith begins with God and His ability to be who He says He is (Hebrews 11:6). Secondly, you must believe (and not doubt) in what you are praying for. Whenever there is doubt, you will tie the hands of God to act on your behalf. Where there is unbelief, we can restrict the power, presence, and participation of God (Mark 6:5,6). Thirdly, you must believe that God will produce what you have prayed for without seeing it. Anyone can believe because they see the outcome, but Jesus says, "So, you believe because you've seen with your own eyes. Even better blessings are in store for those who believe without seeing (John 20:29 MSG)." Remember, Biblical belief is to accept something as fact without having a sense of real evidence. Lastly, when you pray according to God's revealed will, you operate within heavens parameters. You can never ask God for things that violate His laws or His nature (2 Peter 1:3; 1 Timothy 6:17). Never forget that God wants you to experience joy, "This is what I want you to do: Ask the Father for whatever is in keeping with the things I've revealed to you. Ask in my name, according to my will, and he'll most certainly give it to you. Your joy will be a river overflowing its banks (John 16:24)!"

## **PRAYER**

Father, I want to thank you that hear me when I pray. I believe that your word is true and that you keep your promises to your people. You are a covenant-keeping God.

Please strengthen and increase my faith as I pursue your will in my life. In Jesus’ name.

**DECREE**

I decree that you are Jehovah Elohim, the God of might, creative power, and sovereign ability (Jeremiah 32:27, Genesis 46:3). I decree that you are the God who is able to produce His word and His will in the Earth and release your power in the Earth to perform the miraculous and manifest the prayers of the saints.

**REFLECTIONS**

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# DAY 4

## DON'T LOSE YOUR VISION

*Then Nahash the Ammonite came up and encamped against Jabesh Gilead; and all the men of Jabesh said to Nahash, "Make a covenant with us, and we will serve you." And Nahash the Ammonite answered them, "On this condition I will make a covenant with you, that I may put out all your right eyes, and bring reproach on all Israel." Then the elders of Jabesh said to him, "Hold off for seven days, that we may send messengers to all the territory of Israel. And then, if there is no one to save us, we will come out to you." So the messengers came to Gibeah of Saul and told the news in the hearing of the people. And all the people lifted up their voices and wept. 1 Samuel 11:1-4*

*Write the vision and make it plain on tablets, that he may run who reads it. For the vision is yet for an appointed time; But at the end, it will speak, and it will not lie. Though it tarries, wait for it; Because it will surely come, it will not tarry. Habakkuk 2:2,3*

## DEVOTIONAL

Nahash the Ammonite, whose name means serpent or snake, had surrounded Jabesh-Gilead, and the men felt powerless to fight back, so they determined to make a covenant with Ammonites. Then Nahash agreed to make a

covenant with them on one condition: “that I put out all your right eyes.” (1 Samuel 11:2) What is so troubling about the issue is that the men of the city considered for seven days. ultimately, they were delivered by the hand of King Saul. The goal of Nahash was to blind the men of the city so that he could take away their vision.

One of the keys to demonic attacks in your life is too blind or impair your ability to see where you are going. The enemy knows the importance of vision. So, he will apply pressure in every area of your life so that he is able to impair your sight. Satan will attack your family, marriage, church, or your finances so that you get distracted from fulfilling the vision that the Lord has given to you. If you, your family, or your church is going to be successful in this season of acquisition and forward progression – the first thing you will need to do is get a fresh vision from the Lord or tie yourself to another’s vision of victory. Secondly, you will need to write the vision down in a book or put it in a place that you see every day so that you don’t lose focus. Listen to Habakkuk prophetically announce, “Write the vision and make it plain on tablets, that he may run who reads it.” (Habakkuk 2:2) The next thing you will need to do is establish a plan. Take the time to discuss your plan with a prayer partner, spouse or team that will aid you in cultivating your plan to fulfill it. Lastly, keep your God-Vision before the Lord. At least once a week (if not every day), you should be praying about your vision and about the plan of execution. Remember, a vision is a God-ordained picture of what you want to see in your future—a vision maybe of your health, finances, family, or ministry. Once you get your

vision, refuse to let the enemy rob you of what the Lord is showing you.

**PRAYER**

Father, I ask You to reveal the truths in Your Word that will make me the head and not the tail. As I meditate on Your Word, I “see” the vision of success You have for me. I am open to receiving insight from the Holy Spirit. In Jesus’ Name, Amen.

**DECREE**

You are Jehovah-Jireh (Genesis 22:14), You are the Lord who provides and sees all of my needs before they arrive. I decree that every need in my life will be met. I decree that supernatural manifestations of your presence will be commonplace in my life. Wisdom will be released to fulfill every vision that You place before me. I decree You will open my eyes so I can see what You see in this season.

**REFLECTIONS**

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# DAY 5

## DON'T BE DOUBLE MINDED

*But let him ask in faith, nothing wavering. For he that wavereth is like a wave of the sea driven with the wind and tossed. For let not that man think that he shall receive anything of the Lord. A double-minded man is unstable in all his ways. James 1:6-8*

*And not being weak in faith, he did not consider his own body, already dead (since he was about a hundred years old), and the deadness of Sarah's womb. He did not waver at the promise of God through unbelief, but was strengthened in faith, giving glory to God, and being fully convinced that what He had promised He was also able to perform. And therefore "it was accounted to him for righteousness. Romans 4:19-22*

## DEVOTIONAL

Any instability in your life is due to not believing and speaking the Word of God. To live a stable life, you are going to have to consider only what God says, no matter how bad it looks and no matter how your flesh loudly is screaming at you. You have to stay focused on the promise and stagger not (Romans 4:20). If you stay focused on His Word, you will not be double-minded. You will stick with

your belief in God's Word and accept nothing less than what He says. And that means you will get what you say!

Abraham staggered not at the promise of God because he was fully persuaded that God was able also to perform it (Romans 4:21). That's another key right there. Who had promised? It was God who had promised, and it was God who was going to perform it. It wasn't up to Abraham to perform it, and it isn't up to you or me to perform it. What we have to do is believe God's promise, speak His promise, and let Him do the rest. He said He would, and He will. It's a law!

Remember, you are the righteousness of God. You are more than a conqueror. He always causes you to triumph in Christ. You are saved. You are delivered. You are healed. You are rich. You are full of wisdom. Even so, you don't have to fulfill the promise. God has said it, and He will make it good.

Do not be double-minded...Believe God's Word and receive it!

## **PRAYER**

Father, I thank you that I am focused on Your promise (name what you are believing for). Forgive me for allowing doubt and frustration to enter my heart. My faith is not in myself, but in You. I believe what You've said in Your Word will come to pass, and I gratefully receive it. In Jesus' Name, Amen.

# DECREE

I declare that You are Jehovah-Nissi (Exodus 15:15), the Lord, who is my banner in victory. I decree that as You brought Israel out of Egypt and through the wilderness, You will bring me through every challenge and difficulty. I decree that because You are my banner, I will be victorious over the enemy and every obstacle in my life.

## REFLECTIONS

# DAY 6

And those who love it and indulge it will eat its fruit and bear the consequences of their words. Proverbs 18:21

## DEVOTIONAL

By your words, you will either act like God or the devil. You will either express the will and Word of God or the deception and lies of the devil. Once you have that firmly established your choice, you won't care what people say to you or about you because you know who God says you are, and you are determined only to say what He says about you. You know what He says you can have and can do, and that is your confession of faith.

When you begin to operate in the law of confession, you may have problems with other people simply because you haven't built a track record of success. Sometimes you have

to stick your neck out in faith, trust God to perform His Word, and watch the miracles happen a few times before you really become fully assured inside that what you say is going to happen because it is God's Word. There are times when you may feel silly, but that is just another collision between your natural education and your spiritual education. Keep pressing on because you were created to act this way.

After a while, this behavior will become easier and feel more comfortable. You will come to have faith in every word you speak. When a situation arises, you will get God's wisdom on it, speak His Word and will, and then go on to something else because you know your words are going to work exactly as you spoke them. This is how God created you to function in taking dominion over the Earth and replenishing it. This is acting like Him.

It's time you start calling "things that be not as though they were." Then you are going to see miraculous results, just like Abraham and Sarah did!

## **PRAYER**

Father, though I don't yet see it happening in the physical realm, I am going to call (name what you are believing for) to manifest, I believe I receive what You have promised in Your Word. In Jesus' Name, Amen.

# DECREE

I decree You are Jehovah Rapha (Exodus 15:26), the God who heals. I decree that in this season I will be healed, mended, cured, and restored. I decree that I will not be bitter, frustrated, or discouraged because you are my God and my Deliverer.

## REFLECTIONS

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# DAY 7

## THE STRUGGLE IS COMING TO AN END

*And I will restore to you the years that the locust hath eaten, the cankerworm, and the caterpillar, and the palmerworm, my great army which I sent among you. And ye shall eat in plenty, and be satisfied, and praise the name of the Lord your God, that hath dealt wondrously with you: and my people shall never be ashamed. (Joel 2:25-26)*

*The Spirit of the Lord God is upon Me, Because the Lord has anointed Me to preach good tidings to the poor; He has sent Me to heal the brokenhearted, to proclaim liberty to the captives, and the opening of the prison to those who are bound; to proclaim the acceptable year of the Lord, And the day of vengeance of our God; To comfort all who mourn, to console those who mourn in Zion, to give them beauty for ashes, the oil of joy for mourning, the garment of praise for the spirit of heaviness; that they may be called trees of righteousness, the planting of the Lord, that He may be glorified. (Isaiah 61:1-3)*

## DEVOTIONAL

The vengeance of the Lord is not about trusting or relying on an earthly court for justice but to trust only in the Almighty God and the Court of Heaven. In the book of Psalms, it is written, "For promotion cometh neither from



the east, nor from the west, nor from the south. But God is the judge" (Psalm 75:6-7). The New Living Translation says this, "It is God alone who judges; he decides who will rise and who will fall."

In some way or another, the devil has harassed and stolen from many of God's people, everything from health and long life to marriages and financial success. That time is over. The word of the Lord for this season is, "I'm going to restore to you the years..." There is an anointing for restoration, healing, and acquisition. Start proclaiming, 'The days of my struggling are over!'

As a matter of fact, anything from now on that is making you uncomfortable, God is going to remove it. And whatever has been interfering with your destiny, resisting God's plan for your life or holding you back, is going to let you go!

Speak prophetically and say, "Whatever will not let God's plan come to pass in my life is now being removed." Things that are against your peace, your promotion, your progress, and prosperity...God will command vengeance to operate on your behalf.

## **PRAYER**

Father, I thank You for Your vengeance operating on my behalf to bring peace, promotion, progress, and prosperity. I will no longer depend on man or human solutions, but I receive Your restoration in my life concerning (names of

people or situations needing to be restored). In Jesus' Name, Amen.

# DECREE

You are Jehovah Gibbor Milchamah (Psalm 24:8, Isaiah 42:13), You are the Lord who is mighty in battle. I decree that You will fight for me, and You will overcome my enemies. I thank You that You are the God who is Mighty in battle.

## REFLECTIONS
